## The Spaces

## Main Level

Additional seating or buffet staging, plus the perfect backdrop for your main bar in our fireplace room

## Finding Your Ideal Floorplan



#### 100 guests or fewer

You have complete flexibility with this guest count to have dinner and dancing wherever you choose, regardless of whether you choose to have a buffet or plated dinner.

## 100-130 guests

This guest count still gives you a good amount of flexibility in the space and only a small chance of needing to utilize the mezzanine for guest seating depending on your plans for dinner and dancing. Our helpful team can work with you to maximize your vision in this guest count range, which is our most popular event size!

#### 130 guests or more

Once the guest count begins to go above 130, the mezzanine will need to be utilized for additional guest seating. 150-160 is the sweet spot for Citizens while also utilizing the Mezzanine. If your guest count is higher than that, we recommend having a cocktail style reception without assigned seating for each guest.
